1. The present Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely, **Rupan Sah**, who is in judicial custody since 22.05.2026 in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 192/2026, U/s 115(2), 126(2), 117(2), 109(1), 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. is hereby disposed of.

2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 10.05.2026 at about 08:10 p.m., when informant was go to grocery shop, then petitioner-Rupan Sah came there and started to abuse him and assaulted him by means of lathi and called his son Deepak Saw and he also assaulted the informant by means of sword, due to which, his head got cut and other co-accused persons assaulted informant by means of lathi. When informant's mother and brother came to save him, they were also assaulted by the accused persons and snatched Rs. 1,50,000/- from informant, which was bring to his sister's home.

3. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that no other bail application has been filed either in this Ld. Court or the Hon'ble High Court Patna except the present one. Further submitted that earlier, anticipatory bail vide ABA No. 681/2026 filed before the Ld. A.S.J.- VI, Jamui, which has been withdrawn.

4. It is further submitted by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioner that the accused petitioner has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case due to village politics. The petitioner is a man of spotless character and no any criminal antecedent. Further submitted that there is no any specific allegation against the petitioner and all sections are bailable in nature except Section 109(1) of B.N.S., which is not applicable against the petitioner. Further, both parties belongs to Kaleshwar Sah's family and both parties are uncle and nephew same family member. Both parties are on gotia and belong to same genealogical table and for partition of land this case has been lodged.

5. On the other hand, Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail and submitted to reject the same.
6. Heard both the sides and perused the material available on record. The case has been supported by the witnesses but in spite of repeated directions, the Ld. P.P. failed to submit injury report before the Court. Further, para 13 is the report of the FSL wherein it is reported as "no relevant scientific evidence could be found at place of occurrence". Further, it reflects from para 45 of the CD that the petitioner is having clean antecedent. Moreover, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 22.05.2026.
7. Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances and mainly considering the custody period of the petitioner, a lenient approach can be taken with respect to the petitioner's prayer of Regular Bail. Accordingly, the Regular Bail Petition of the following, the accused-petitioner, namely, **Rupan Sah**, is hereby **Allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/-with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below with the condition that, one of the bailor must be family member/close relative.
8. The observation made in the present bail petition order are for purpose of deciding the present petition and do not affect the factual matrix of investigation / trial of the present case, which is separate issue as per law.
