ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition was filed under section 482 of BNSS on behalf of Tarun kumar Verma who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Parasbigha P.S. Case No. 25/26** for the offence **under Section 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B) of IPC** which is pending in the court of **Sri Kumar Saurav, J.M. 1st, class Jehanabad.**

The prosecution case as stated by the informant Vindyachal Prasad who is Deputy Superintendent, in Bureau of Vigilance Investigation has submitted in his written application in brief is that in light of the order passed by the Honorable High Court of Bihar, Patna, in Public Interest Litigation No. CWJC No. 15459/14, district-wise officers have been deputed to verify the educational/training mark sheets/certificates of employed teachers. In light of the said order, he has been deputed to verify the educational/training certificates of Jehanabad district. Upon review of the folder provided by the Planning Unit, Gram Panchayat Mandil, Block-Jehanabad, District-Jehanabad, and the office letter No. 518 dated 30.11.2022 of the Block Education Officer, Jehanabad, it has been found that employed Panchayat Teacher Tarun Kumar Verma, date of birth: 10.06.1983 (age approximately 42 years), father: Krishna Murari Singh, Village Yoga Bigha, Post Office: Madil, Police Station: Paras Bigha, District-Jehanabad, was appointed in the year 2003 on the basis of merit in Matriculation marks at Primary School Yoga Bigha, currently Primary School Salempur No. 2, Gram Panchayat Mandil, Block- Jehanabad, District-Jehanabad. The Block

Education Officer, Jehanabad, District-Jehanabad, has reported in his office letter No. 84, dated 20.02.2022, regarding the current status of the teacher, Tarun Kumar Verma, Primary School Yoga Bigha, currently Primary School Salempur No. 2, Planning Unit, Gram Panchayat Mandil, Block-Jehanabad, District. Currently employed in Jehanabad and receiving a regular salary. His Matriculation mark sheet with Roll Code-08402, Roll No.-0121, Year 1998, Marks-589, Category-1st, was sent for verification to the Bihar School Examination Board, Patna. In the verification report of the Bihar School Examination Board, Patna, No. BSEB/VVC/586/2021, dated 05.06.2021, Tarun Kumar Verma's Matriculation mark sheet with Roll Code-08402, Roll No.-0121. Year 1908 (A), Marks obtained-307, Category-III (3) Total Marks is recorded as fake showing mismatched. Again in the verification report provided by Bihar School Examination Board, Patna through letter no.-BSEB/VVC/956/2022, dated-30.11.2022, Tarun Kumar Verma, father- Krishna Murari Singh, matriculation mark sheet roll code-08402, roll no.-0121, year- 1998 (A) marks obtained-589. Category-1 (1) is marked CORRECT. In the event of receipt of the above two types of verification reports, correspondence was made with the Bihar School Examination Board, Patna through letter no. 1357/N.Shi.Ko. dated 11.12.2025 to determine which verification report is correct. The verification report provided by the Bihar School Examination Board, Patna through its letter no. BSEB/VVC/130/2025, dated 20.12.2025, clearly states that letter no. BSEB/VVC/586/2021, dated 05.06.2021, was issued by the Monitoring Verification Cell of the Board, while letter no. B5EB/VVC/956/2022, dated 30.11.2022, was not issued by the Monitoring Verification Cell of the Board. In such a situation, the verification report of the Bihar School Examination Board, Patna In light of letter number BSEB/VVC/586/2021, dated 05.06.2021, Tarun Kumar Verma's matriculation mark sheet has been found to be fake.

Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submitted that accused-petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence whatsoever and furthermore there is no criminal antecedent against him. He submits that the petitioner is not concerned with the alleged occurrence in any manner. He is implicated in this case due to previous enmity. Accordingly, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioner.

Learned A.P.P. Sunil Kumar Singh vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the record. Perusal of the case diary shows that all prosecution witnesses have supported the case of prosecution which is evident from para 16 and 22 of the case diary. On perusal of the case diary it appears that the petitioner allegedly tried to pollute the most important and pious stream of education firstly by presenting fake certificate and getting

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job and then again by getting certificate termed correct during investigation. The accused/petitioner took the job of a teacher by submitting wrong documents putting future of students at stake. The allegations against the petitioner are serious and offence is grave. Considering the nature of allegation and gravity of offence I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioner. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition stands **rejected**.
