ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition was filed under section 482 of BNSS on behalf of above named accused petitioners who apprehend their arrest in connection with **Hulasganj PS Case No. 62/2025** for the offence **under section 191(1), 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 352, 324(4), 303(2) BNS and 27 Arms Act** which is pending in the court of **Ld. C.J.M., Jehanabad.**

The prosecution case as stated in the written report of the informant Baso Yadav in brief is that he was feeding his cattle when Ravi Kumar came firing and attacked his house. He fell unconscious and then Kamlesh Yadav assaulted him with iron rod which caused injury to his hand. Awadhesh Yadav assaulted him with Lathi because of which his elbow got injured. Varun Kumar, Tarun Kumar and Arun Kumar were having Falsa and they attacked him but he escaped and in the meantime his sister-in-law Sonfi Devi came and took him inside the house. Pawan Kumar and Praveen Kumar snatched his gold chain. Babloo yadav, Rajan Kumar and Rajesh Kumar were having Lathi. Amit Kumar and Sindhu Yadav damaged the Asbestos.

Ld. counsel for the accused petitioners submitted that accused petitioners are innocent and there is no criminal antecedent against them. He submits that entire allegation are false and fabricated and as a matter of fact accused persons and informant are co-villagers and because of previous enmity he has filed this false case. He submits that there is no time and date of occurrence mentioned in the FIR. He submits that as a matter of fact accused petitioner Ravi Kumar is a student and he was coming back after tuition and then informant side assaulted him very badly and for this

reason Hulasganj P.S. case no. 61/2025 was registered and the present case was filed by the informant to get himself saved from that case. Accordingly, it is prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioners.

Learned APP Sunil Kumar Singh vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the record. Perusal of the record shows that case diary is available on record which includes injury report of only one person namely Baso Yadav. As per this report nature of injury is simple. There is no time and date of occurrence mentioned in the FIR. Considering all the facts and circumstances, it is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the Court below/concerned police within fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners will be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) of BNSS.
