ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition was filed under section 482 of BNSS on behalf of above named accused petitioners who apprehend their arrest in connection with **Kako PS Case No. 444/25** for the offence **under section 190, 191, 191(2), 191(3), 126, 127, 303, 308, 310, 351(4), 352, 3(5) of BNS** which is pending in the court of **Ld. S.D.J.M, Jehanabad.**

The prosecution case, as stated in the complaint petition of the complainant Ranjeet Kumar in brief, that on 03.07.2025 at about 04.00 P.M. the complainant along with his father, mother and Amarjeet Chaudhary after reserving an auto proceeded from the house of his uncle at Village- Kishunpur. It is further stated that as they reached near RCC bridge between Ramdani and Kanakbiga village then all the petitioners including 6-7 unknown persons surrounded them and then took the complainant out from the auto and snatched a bag containing 4 lacs rupees. On objection all the accused persons assaulted the complainant with intention to kill with lathi, danda and pistol's butt. Because of this he fall down on the ground and blood started oozing out from his mouth and nose. When his mother tried to save him then accused Dhanmanti Devi and Mintra Devi assaulted her with lathi. When other persons came to save them all the accused persons fled away with looted amount and threatened for dire consequences.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners submits that the accused petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence whatsoever and furthermore there is no criminal antecedent against them. He

submits that as a matter of fact this false case was registered due to previous matrimonial dispute between informant and petitioners. He submits that informant Ranjeet Kumar is husband of petitioner Dhanmanti Devi but he has deliberately suppressed this fact. On being asked he further submits that he has not filed any case against the informant side related to matrimonial dispute because petitioner side wanted to continue the matrimonial relationship peacefully. Accordingly, it is prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioners.

Learned APP Sunil Kumar Singh opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the record. Perusal of record shows that case diary is available on record which includes injury report. As per injury reports nature of injury is simple. Para no. 16 of the case diary is worth mentioning. It is also important to mention that this case was instituted on the basis of complaint petition which was referred for institution of FIR. Petitioner no. 2 Dhanmanti Devi as per this bail petition is wife of informant. Considering all the facts and circumstances, including submission made by counsel, it is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the Court below/concerned police within fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners will be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) of BNSS.
