ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely 1. Uday Kumar, 2. Arun Kumar 3. Mallu Kumar and 4. Yogendra Kumar @ Joginder Yadav, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with, Pali P.S Case no. 24-2026 for offence U/Ss-126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352 and 3(5) B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application and the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that both parties are Gotiya and there is land dispute between them. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties vide Pali P.S Case no. 25/2026. It is further submitted that there is no repetition of blow as well as no intervening circumstances hence section 109 B.N.S is not attracted. At last prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

On the other hand, the learned P.P has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Parwati Devi, is that on 29-01-2026, at about 12-30 P.M, some altercation

took place between the parties for measurement of land by government Amin and allegedly, the petitioners and the co-accused Ramjee Prasad began to abuse the informant and the petitioner Uday Kumar threw the informant on the surface by catching her hair and subsequently, the petitioners Arun Kumar, Malu Kumar and Yogendra Kumar started dragging her with bad intention. It is further alleged that the co-accused Ramjee Prasad assaulted the informant by means of *Lohbandi Lathi* causing head injury and blood started oozing out. It is further alleged that when the informant's mother-in-law came there to save, she was also assaulted by means of slap and fist by the accused persons and the petitioner Uday Kumar snatched gold Mangalsutra and ~~from~~ ^{from} the neck of the informant's mother-in-law. On Hulla, the villagers came there and intervened. The injured was brought P.H.C, Kako for treatment. Accordingly, the F.I.R has been registered.

Perused the record. On perusal of record, it appears that both the parties are Gotiya and there is case and counter case as well as land dispute between the parties. It appears from injury report attached to the case diary that the doctor has found simple injury caused by hard and blunt substance on the person of the injured. As per para 27 of the case diary, the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **allowed** and in case of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners 1. Uday Kumar, 2. Arun Kumar 3. Mallu Kumar and 4. Yogendra Kumar @ Joginder Yadav are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned subject to conditions laid down u/s- 482(2) of BNSS.
