ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Ghamandi Yadav, who is in custody since 02.02.2026, in connection with, Pali P. S. Case no. 25-2026 for offence U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioner either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against this petitioner and there is case and counter case between the parties and the allegation of theft appears to be ornamental. However, the petitioner is in custody since 02-02-2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant namely, Reena Kumari, is that on 29-01-2026 at about 12.30 P. M., some altercation took place between the parties for measurement of land by government Amin and allegedly, the petitioner and the co-accused persons refused to measure the said land and when the same was protested, the petitioner and the co-accused persons began to abuse and assault by means of bricks stone. It is also alleged that the co-accused Kaushal Kumar assaulted the informant's brother-in-law

Arun Kumar by means of Lathi causing head injury and blood started oozing out. It is further alleged that the co-accused Mritunjay Kumar snatched gold Mangalsutra and Durga Jee from the informant's Gotini Shanti Devi. On Hulla, the villagers came and intervened. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner and there is case and counter case between the parties. It also appears from the injury report attached to the case diary that the doctor has found simple injury caused by hard and blunt substance on the person of the injured. The petitioner is in custody since 02-02-2026 and as per para-25 of the case diary, the petitioner has no criminal history.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioner namely Ghamandi Yadav, is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
