ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P. P. for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely (1) Kaushal Kumar, (2) Mritunjay Kumar, (3) Chulu Yadav, (4) Nawal Yadav @ Nagal and (5) Banti Kumar, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with, Pali P. S. Case No. 25-2026 for offence U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the B. N. S. .

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court nor the same is pending prior to this application and the petitioner has got no criminal history. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case as well as land dispute between the parties and the allegation of theft appears to be ornamental. At last prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

The learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant namely, Reena Kumari, is that on 29-01-2026 at about 12.30 P. M., some altercation took place between the parties for measurement of land by government Amin and allegedly, the petitioners and the co-accused person refused to measure the said land and

when the same was protested, the petitioners and the co-accused persons began to abuse and assault by means of bricks stone. It is also alleged that the petitioner Kaushal Kumar assaulted the informant's brother-in-law Arun Kumar by means of Lathi causing head injury and blood started oozing out. It is further alleged that the petitioner Mritunjay Kumar snatched gold Mangalsutra and Durga Jee from the informant's Gotini Shanti Devi. On Hulla, the villagers came and intervened. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of record, it appears that there is case and counter case as well as land dispute between the parties and as per injury report attached to the case diary, the doctor has found simple injury on the person of the injured. As per para-25 of the case diary, the petitioners have got no criminal history.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **allowed** and in case of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners (1) Kaushal Kumar, (2) Mritunjay Kumar, (3) Chulu Yadav, (4) Nawal Yadav @ Nagal, (5) Banti Kumar, are ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned subject to conditions laid down u/s- 482(2) of B. N. S. S.
