**ORDER**

**11.03.2026**

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Pintoo Das, who is in custody since 07.02.2026, in connection with, Hulasganj P. S. Case no. 364-2025 for offence U/Ss, 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 281, 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioner either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against this petitioner and there is case and counter case between the parties and a joint compromise petition has been filed in which it is mentioned that both parties have amicably settled their case and they don't want to proceed further with this case. However, the petitioner is in custody since 07-02-2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned P. P. has conceded the factum of compromise.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant namely, Manoj Das, is that on 23-11-2025 at about 7.00 P. M., the co-accused Mantoo Das dashed the informant's son Prithvi Kumar by his motorcycle and when the informant asked about the said incident, the petitioner and other co-accused persons concertedly began to abuse and assault indiscriminately as a result of which the informant and his family members sustained head injuries. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner and there is case and counter case between the parties. It also appears from the injury report attached to the case diary that the doctor has found simple injury caused by hard and blunt substance on the person of the injured. The petitioner is in custody since 07-02-2026 and as per para-25 of the case diary, the petitioner has no criminal history.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioner namely Pintoo Das, is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
