ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P. for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely 1. Nonu Yadav, 2. Anil Kumar, 3. Amit kumar, 4. Sonu Kumar and 5. Md. Shanawaj Hussain @ Sahanaj Hussain, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with, Shakurabad P.S. Case no. 22/2026 for offences U/Ss-191(2), 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 303(2), 352 and 74 B.N.S. and 27 Arms Act.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application and the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties. It is further submitted that the allegation of theft appears to be ornamental. At last prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

On the other hand, the learned P.P. has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Vijay Sharma is that on 22-01-2026 at about 03:00 P.M., there happened some altercation for selling Newari between the informant and his Bataidar Shahanwaj

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Hussain. It is alleged that the petitioners and the co-accused persons equipped with deadly weapon came there and began to abuse the informant. It is further alleged that they opened fire while entering into the house of the informant and began to damage the household articles and when the informant's wife Rekha Devi protested, the co-accused Sonu Kumar assaulted by means of iron rod on her waist. It is further alleged that the accused persons threw the informant and pressed his neck with towel and the petitioner Amit Kumar snatched gold chain from the neck of the informant's wife and cash amount of Rs. 2,000/- from the pocket of the informant. Thereafter, they also entered into the house of his neighbour and committed Marpit. Accordingly, F.I.R has been registered.

Perused the record. On perusal of record, it appears that there is case and counter case between the parties. It further appears that the injury report attached to the case diary shows that the doctor has found simple injury on the person of the injured. As per para 22 of the case diary, the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **allowed** and in case of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners 1. Nonu Yadav, 2. Anil Kumar, 3. Amit kumar, 4. Sonu Kumar and 5. Md. Shanawaj Hussain @ Sahanaj Hussain are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- each, with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned subject to the condition laid down u/s- 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
