## ORDER

13.03.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P. P. for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely (1) Surendra Yadav, (2) Manti Devi, (3) Ranju Devi, (4) Khushboo Devi, (5) Rubi Devi, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with, Parasbigha P. S. Case No. 32-2026 for offence U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent, they have committed no offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court nor the same is pending prior to this application and the petitioners have got criminal antecedent of one case which was ended. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and both parties are the members of the same family and there is land dispute between them. It is further submitted that a joint compromise petition has been filed in which it is mentioned that both parties have amicably settled their case and they don't want to proceed further with this case. At last, prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

The learned P. P. has conceded the factum of compromise between both the parties.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Naresh Singh Yadav, is that on 22-01-2026 at about 06.00 P. M., while the informant was sitting at his house, in the mean time, the co-accused Abhay Yadav came there and began to

abuse the informant and when the same was protested, the co-accused Abhay Yadav and Vinay Yadav assaulted the informant by means of iron rod causing head injury. It is further alleged that on Hulla, when the family members of the informant came there to save, they were assaulted by means of Lathi and iron rod by the accused persons as a result of which the informant and his family members sustained injuries. It is further alleged that the co-accused Subhash Yadav and Vishal Kumar threw Duli Devi on the ground and they attempted to kill by pressing her neck and the accused persons also damaged motorcycle, tiles and asbestos of the house whereas the co-accused Abhay Yadav snatched gold Mangalsutra from the neck of the informant's wife. Accordingly, F. I. R. has been registered.

Perused the record. On perusal of record, it appears that there is case and counter case between the parties and both parties are the members of the same family and there is land dispute between them. It further appears that the injury reports attached to the case diary show that the doctor has found simple injuries on the person of the injured. The allegation of theft is not supported by the witnesses in their statements recorded in para 07, 08, 99 and 100 of the case diary.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **allowed** and in case of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners (1) Surendra Yadav, (2) Manti Devi, (3) Ranju Devi, (4) Khushboo Devi, (5) Rubi Devi, are ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/-each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned, subject to conditions laid down u/s- 482(2) of B. N. S. S. (Dictated)
