ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Birendra Prasad, who is in custody since 18.02.2026, in connection with, Barabar Prayatak (Bishunganj O.P.) P. S. Case no. 5-2026 for offence U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that earlier an anticipatory bail petition was filed on behalf of the petitioner which was dismissed as withdrawn thereafter, no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioner either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioner has no criminal history. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 18.02.2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Prashant Kumar, is that on 08.01.2026 at about 6:00 A.M., when the

informant's father went to attend nature's call then due to previous enmity, the petitioner along with another co-accused Sunita Devi with an intention to kill, brutally assaulted the informant's father by means of Lathi, Danda and sharp edged weapon due to which he sustained injury, thereafter he was treated in Makhdumpur hospital. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner and there is case and counter case between the parties. It further appears from injury report attached to the case diary that the doctor has found simple injury on the person of the injured. The petitioner is in custody since 18.02.2026 and as per para-3 of the bail petition, the petitioner has no criminal history.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody and the clean antecedent of the petitioner, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioner namely Birendra Prasad, is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
