ORDER

19.03.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Surishth Kumar and (2) Sumit Kumar, who are in custody since 18.02.2026, in connection with, Makhdumpur P. S. Case No. 9-2026 for offence U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 352, 109(1) and 3(5) B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no B. P or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioners either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the petitioners are in custody since 18-02-2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the fardbayan of the informant Marchhi Devi, is that on 01-01-2026, at about 06-00 P. M., when the informant's son Prince Kumar was going to purchase vegetable at Sarthua market, in the mean time, the petitioners and the co-accused persons forcibly stopped his motorcycle and began to abuse him and when the same was protested, the accused persons including the petitioners began to assault the informant's son Prince Kumar indiscriminately as a result of which the victim lost his consciousness. The injured



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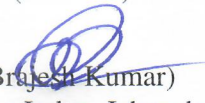
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was brought to Sukhdeo Prasad Verma Referral Hospital, Makhdumpur from where he was referred to sadar hospital, Jehanabad. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that the petitioners are named in the FIR with allegation that they and the co-accused person assaulted the informant's son indiscriminately and the allegation is supported by the injury report attached to the case diary in which the doctor has found swelling 5 Cm x 3 Cm on left eye, grievous in nature and NCCT face-multiple bone fracture (#) with haemorrhagic sinus, SC edema and emphysema over left side of face, on the person of the injured. The informant in her re-statement in para-11 of the case diary and the witness in para-5 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to allow this bail petition and accordingly this bail petition is hereby **rejected.**
