Heard the learned counsel for the appellant on the point of admission and perused the record.

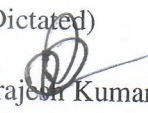
From perusal of record, it appears that this criminal appeal has been filed by the appellant who is the informant and victim of Kako P.S case no. 05/2017 against the judgment and order of acquittal dated 23.01.2025 passed by Sri Ankit Rajan, J.M.F.C, Jehanabad in Kako P.S case no. 05/2017, G.R no. 24/2017 (State Vs. Ram Ishwar Yadav and others).

From perusal of Sheristedar's report it appears that the only defect pointed out by the Sheristedar is that this appeal is time barred regarding which the learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that for condonation of delay a petition u/s-5 of Limitation Act has been filed stating therein that after knowledge, the appellant obtained certified copy of judgment and other papers on 20.02.2025 and after that the appellant handed over the file to his lawyer who after drafting the memo of appeal handed over the file to the appellant on 20.04.2025 and got it typed and filed the same without further delay and there is no intentional delay on the part of the appellant.

After hearing the learned counsel for the appellant/informant (victim) this appeal is admitted subject to hearing on point of limitation at the time of final decision. Call for lower court record. Issue notice against the respondents for which the appellant is directed to file requisites.

Put up on 25.06.2025 for lower court record and filing of requisites for notice.
