ORDER

19.03.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Ram Swaroop Yadav, who is in custody since 27.02.2026, in connection with, Shakurabad P. S. Case no. 01-2026 for offence U/Ss. 191(2), 191(3), 109, 126(2) and 190 B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that earlier, ABP No. 304-2026 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner which was dismissed as withdrawn and except that, no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioner either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against this petitioner and there is case and counter case as well as land dispute between the parties. It is further submitted that the co-accused Shambhu Kumar has been enlarged on bail by order dated 07-02-2026 passed in B. P. No. 42-2026 by this court and the petitioner is in custody since 27-02-2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Ramekwal Singh, is that on 01-01-2026, at about 6-30 P. M., when the informant was sitting at his Dalan, in the mean time, the petitioner and the co-accused persons, equipped with Lathi, Danda and rod assaulted the informant who sustained



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head injury and blood was oozing out. It is further alleged that the co-accused Ashish Kumar @ Deepak Kumar assaulted the informant by means of Lathi as a result of which he sustained injuries on his both hands. The injured was treated in P. H. C., Ratani Faridpur, Jehanabad. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner and there is case and counter case as well as land dispute between the parties. It also appears from the injury report attached to the case diary that the doctor has found simple injury caused by hard and blunt substance on the person of the injured. The petitioner is in custody since 27-02-2026 and as per para-29 of the case diary, the petitioner has no criminal history.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioner namely Ram Swaroop Yadav, is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
