Kako(Bhelawar) P.S Case No. 300/2023
Vinit Kumar v/s State of Bihar

07.04.2026 A regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused Vinit Kumar, who is in custody since 07.03.2026 in connection with Kako(Bhelawar) P.S Case No. 300/2023 lodged u/Ss 147, 148, 323, 341, 342, 307, 379, 504, 506 of IPC, has been pressed today.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the state.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 24.08.2023 at about 12.10 A.M., while the informant was living with sister in her house, in that course, petitioners besides co-accused persons abused by saying his caste name and also assaulted him by means of rod, lathi and legs as a result of which he became unconscious and they also snatched his mobile. Thereafter, his family members brought him to Sadar Hospital, Jehanabad where from doctor has referred to PMCH, Patna for better medical treatment. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case at the instance of his enemies. It is further submitted that no bail petition has been filed before this court and Hon'ble High Court, Patna, nor the same is pending anywhere. Further, the petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2026. So, it is prayed to grant bail to the petitioner.

The learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both the parties and perused the case record. Perusal of the case record shows that there is allegation the present petitioner that he along with other co-accused persons abused the informant by saying his caste name and also

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assaulted him by means of rod, lathi and legs as a result of which he became unconscious and they also snatched his mobile. The corresponding injury report shows that there is no external injury found upon the body of the informant. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2026. Considering the above said facts and circumstances of the case as well as detention period of the petitioner Vinit Kumar, the regular bail petition of the petitioner is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties each to the satisfaction of Id. Lower court.
