ORDER

06.04.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P. P. for the State as well as the learned counsel for the informant on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners 1. Sikandar Chaudhary, 2. Sharwan Chaudhary, 3. Manish Chaudhary and 4. Babita Devi, who are in custody since 08.03.2026, in connection with, Kako P. S. Case no. 94-2026 for offence U/Ss. U/Ss. 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2) and 109 B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that earlier, no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioners either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioners no. 1 to 3 have no criminal history whereas petitioner no. 4 has criminal history of one case in which she is on bail. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners rather there is general and omnibus allegation against them. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and both the cases have been compromised and in support of this, compromise petition is annexed with this bail petition. The



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petitioner is in custody since 08.03.2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

Both the parties appeared before this court and conceded the factum of compromise to which the learned P.P. has also admitted this fact.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Dhanvanti Devi is that on 05.03.2026 at about 9 A.M., when the informant's son went to feed cow, in the meantime, co-accused persons started abusing the informant's son thereafter the informant's son ran away from there. It is further alleged that when the informant and her husband went to the house of co-accused persons for pacifying the matter then the petitioners and co-accused persons equipped with Lathi-Danda, brick and rod assaulted the family members of the informant. Thereafter the injured were taken to Sadar hospital, Jehanabad from where they were referred to PMCH, Patna for better treatment. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners and there is case and counter case between the parties. As per para-23 of the case diary, it appears that the family members of the injured did not produce the medical prescription of the injured. The petitioners are in custody since 08.03.2026.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioners namely 1. Sikandar Chaudhary, 2. Sharwan Chaudhary, 3. Manish Chaudhary and 4. Babita Devi, are ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/-each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
