ORDER

14.05.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Ramashray Yadav, who is in custody since 03.03.2026, in connection with, Ghoshi P. S. Case no. 91-2026 for offence U/Ss.-191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 109, 118(1), 117(2), 303(2), 74 and 76 of B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that earlier no B.P or A.B.P has been filed either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court. It is further submitted that the petitioner has criminal history of one case. It is further submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 03-03-2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant namely, Mithlesh Kumar, is that on 01-03-2026 at

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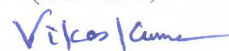
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about 04.00 P.M., the informant was working in his field and in the meantime, the co-accused persons are said to be committed Marpit with the informant, his wife and son due to which they sustained injuries and the co-accused persons also snatched earrings, mobile and silver ornament and also outraged the modesty of the informant's wife. It is further alleged that the allegation against the petitioner is that he committed Marpit with the informant's daughter. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of record, it appears from the F.I.R that the petitioner assaulted the informant's daughter but no injury report has been found. It further appears that the injury reports attached to the case diary show that the doctor has found one injury on metacarpal of left hand of the injured Biku Kumar which is grievous in nature but not on the vital part of the body. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 03-03-2026.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, the period of custody, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioner namely Ramashray Yadav is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
