ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition was filed under section 482 of BNSS on behalf of above named accused petitioners who apprehends their arrest in connection with **Kako PS Case No. 114/26** for the offence **under section 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5)** which is pending in the court of **S.D.J.M, Jehanabad**.

The prosecution case as stated by the informant Md. Taukir Aalam in his written report in brief is that on 20.03.2026 at about 08:30 A.M. when he went to call above named petitioners for drain cleaning then the petitioners started abusing him. In the meantime suddenly petitioner no. 1 (Prakash Chaudhary) assaulted him by means of Pasuli (sharp weapon) on his head. On hearing hue and cry villagers gathered and petitioners fled away.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners submits that the accused petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence whatsoever and furthermore there are no criminal antecedents against them. He submits that they have been falsely implicated in this false case. There is case and counter case between the parties. Accordingly, it is prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioners.

Learned APP Sunil Kumar Singh vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the record. Perusal of record shows that injury report is available on record. The nature of injury sustained by injured is opined to be simple. There is case and counter case between the parties as submitted by the petitioner's side. Considering all the facts and circumstances, it is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the Court below/concerned police within fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners will be released on bail on furnishing bail

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bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) of BNSS. **It is further directed that the accused-petitioners will remain physically present on every date before trial court and if they fail to appear physically for two consecutive dates without proper explanation, the trial court will be at liberty to cancel their bail bond.**
