ORDER

16.04.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely 1. Ramprit Chauhan and 2. Rajesh Chauhan, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with Makhdumpur P.S case no. 820/2025 for offence U/Ss-126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 303(2) and 3(5) B.N.S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application and petitioner no. 2 Rajesh Chauhan has got criminal antecedent of one case whereas petitioner no. 1 has got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that no specific allegation of assault is attributed against the petitioners. At last prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

On the other hand, the learned P.P has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Dattu Chauhan is that on 18.10.2025 at about 07:30 P.M, an altercation took place between the informant's son and the co-accused Jitendra Chauhan for switching the bulb on due to which the co-accused persons along with the petitioners began to abuse the informant's son and on protest by the informant's son Bipin Kumar, the accused persons assaulted him due to which he sustained injury. It is further alleged that the petitioner Rajesh Chauhan snatched gold locket of Bajrangbali from the informant's son. Accordingly F.I.R has been registered.



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Perused the record. On perusal of record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners. It further appears from the injury report attached to the case diary that the injury of the injured is simple in nature.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **allowed** and in case of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners 1. Ramprit Chauhan and 2. Rajesh Chauhan are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned subject to conditions laid down u/s/-482(2) of B.N.S.S.
