ORDER

16.04.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely 1. Sunny Kumar and 2. Rajeshwar Ram, who are in custody since 10.02.2026, in connection with, Jehanabad (Kalpa) P. S. Case no. 128/2026 for offence under sections 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 85 and 80 of the B. N. S. and sections 34 of Dowry Prohibition Act..

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioners either in this court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioner Sunny Kumar has got no criminal history whereas the petitioner Rajeshwar Ram has got criminal history of one case. It is further submitted that petitioner no. 01 is the husband whereas petitioner no. 02 is the father-in-law of the deceased and the deceased died due to sudden illness. At last, it is submitted that the petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Sanjay Ram, is that he performed the marriage of his niece Kajal Kumari with the petitioner Sunny Kumar 10 months ago as per Hindu rites and customs and after the marriage, the informant's niece started living at her sasural



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where she was subjected to cruelty for dowry. She was beaten several times and she was also threatened to kill by the accused persons for dowry demand. It is further alleged that on 04-02-2026, the informant got information that the petitioners and the co-accused persons had caused death of the informant's niece by pressing her neck and on this information, the informant and others went to village Jamuk where they came to know that the dead body of the informant's niece was taken to sadar hospital, Jehanabad for postmortem. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. On perusal of record, it appears that the petitioners are named in the FIR. The petitioners are the husband and the father-in-law of the victim whose death has occurred in her matrimonial house within 7 years of marriage and there is allegation in the FIR that the accused persons including the petitioners subjected her to cruelty soon before her death for fulfilment of dowry demand. The informant in his re-statement in para-03 and the witnesses in their statements in para 09 and 10 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case. The petitioner Rajeshwar Ram has criminal history of one case. The offence is serious in nature.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case and the gravity of offence, I am not inclined to allow this bail petition and accordingly, this bail petition is hereby **rejected**.
