Vikash Kumar @ Sonu Kumar v/s State of Bihar

An application for bail has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely, Vikash Kumar @ Sonu Kumar, who in custody since 28.01.2026, in connection with Shakurabad P.S. Case No. 188/2024 lodged under Sections 309(4) B.N.S. has been pressed today for hearing .

Heard Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Umesh Ravidas as well as Mr. Shardanand Kumar, learned P.P.

Prosecution case as per written report of informant Sashikant Kumar, in brief, is that on 04.08.2024 at about 02:30 pm while he was returning to home Aanua from Chainplura, on motorcycle and came 200 meters forward from Fauladpur market stopped his motorcycle came down for discharging urinal. In the meantime, three persons from Kurtha side boarded on Apachi motorcycle came there and two boys came closer to him and on the point of pistol snatched Golden locket, purse containing Aadhar card, pan card, ATM card, Registration certificate of bike and case Rs 800/-, bag containing two set wearing cloths, charger and Bluetooth and key of the bike and returned back and fled away towards Kurtha.

It has been submitted on behalf of the accused petitioner by his learned counsel that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged in the FIR. Petitioner carries six criminal cases as 1. Shakurabad (Jehanabad) P.S. case no. 201/2024, 2. Alipur (Gaya) P.S. case no. 112/2024, 3. Paibigha (Gaya) P.S. case no. 19/2024, 4. Belanganj (Gaya) P.S. case no. 465/24, 5. Bhagwan (Patna) P.S.139/2024 and 6. Belanganj (Gaya) P.S. case no. 482/2024 in his credit. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has come in the confessional statement of co-accused Bittu Kuamr @ Santan Kuamr, which has been mentioned in para no. 26 of the case diary. Petitioner has no concerned with the alleged commission of offence and is languishing in custody since 28.01.2026. Accordingly, prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

On the other hand, Learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that petitioner carries 06 criminal cases in his credit.

Heard and perused the case record as well as case diary. From the perusal of record, it transpires that petitioner is not named in the FIR. From the perusal of para no. 26 of the case diary it shows that name of the petitioner has come in the confessional statement of co-accused Bittu Kumar @ Santan Kuamr but besides these no any materials is available on the record regarding involvement of the petitioner in the alleged commission of offence. From the perusal of case record, it appears that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It also appears that charge sheet has been submitted. Petitioner is in custody since 28.01.2026.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case and incarceration period of the petitioner, I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail. Hence, above named accused petitioner is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld Trial Court subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be his family member whereas another bailor shall be close relative of the petitioner, who file affidavit as to how he/she is related with the petitioner with further condition that petitioner shall furnish his bail bond after framing of charge and also filed an undertaking that he never indulged in similar offences in future.
