Kako P.S Case No. 29/2026
Badal Kumar @ Rahul v/s State of Bihar

21.04.2026 A regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused Badal Kumar @ Rahul, who is in custody since 07.03.2026 in connection with Kako P.S Case No. 29/2026 lodged u/s 309(4) of BNS, 2023 has been pressed today.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the state.

The prosecution case as per written application of informant Pintu Kumar submitting therein that he works as a delivery boy in Jehanabad. On 16.01.2026, after completing my deliveries, I was returning from Bandhuganj to my office in Jehanabad. At around 8:30 PM, near Mahabodhi School, about 100 yards west, a motorcycle passed very close to me from the east side. I slowed down my vehicle, and suddenly three boys came from the roadside and surrounded me. They forcibly snatched ₹25,000 and my Oppo mobile phone (IMEI No. 862464073435211 and 862464073435203). One of the boys, identified as Chandan, a tall, fair-complexioned person with a marked cheek, resident of Sukhdev Bigha, was known to me. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case at the instance of his enemies. It is further submitted that no bail petition has been filed before this court and Hon'ble High Court, Patna, nor the same is pending anywhere. Therefore, the present is being filed before this court prior to this application either before this learned court or before Hon'ble High Court and nor the same is pending anywhere. Further, the petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2026. So, it is prayed to grant bail to the petitioner.

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The learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both the parties and perused the case record. Perusal of the case record shows that an FIR under Section 309(4) has been registered. The petitioner is not named in the FIR, his name has surfaced during the course of interrogation of accused Chandan Kumar who has disclosed his name as co-accused in his confessional statements whereas no any incriminating articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2026. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as detention period of the petitioner Badal Kumar @ Rahul, the bail is hereby **allowed** on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties each to the satisfaction of Id. Lower court subject to condition that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and wherever he is required by the IO or the court the petitioner shall remain present failing which the bail bonds of the petitioner stands cancelled.
