ORDER

18.04.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P. P. for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely (1) Pahaladi Das @ Prahalad Kumar and (2) Dularchan Das, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with, Makhdumpur P. S. Case No. 182-2026 for offence under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118, 109(1), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of B. N. S.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent, they have committed no offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court nor the same is pending prior to this application and the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners and there is case and counter case between the parties. At last, prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant namely, Santosh Kumar, is that on 04-03-2026 at about 05.00 P. M., the informant was sitting at his house, then all of a sudden, the petitioners and the co-accused persons came there and began to abuse the informant and when the same was protested, the accused persons assaulted the informant. It is further alleged that the co-accused Santosh Das assaulted the wife of the informant's brother Punam Devi by



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means of Lathi causing head injury whereas the co-accused Vinay Das inflicted knife blows on the back and hand of the informant . The villagers came and intervened. The accused persons threatened to kill the informant. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of the record, it appears that the petitioners are named in the FIR with allegation that they have actively participated in the alleged occurrence of assault in which two persons have sustained injuries and the allegation of assault has been corroborated by the injury reports of the injured attached to the case diary in which the doctor has found laceration on the centre of scalp of Punam Kumari whereas the injured Santosh Das has sustained stab wound on back of chest caused by sharp pointed object. The injuries are on vital parts of the body of the injured. It further appears that the informant in his re-statement in para-2 and the witnesses in paras-3, 4 and 5 of the case diary have supported the prosecution case and the investigation of this case is still going on. It further appears that the co-accused persons have been granted regular bail by this court. It is not a fit case for grant anticipatory bail.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners and accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby rejected. However, if so advised, the petitioners may surrender before the learned Court below and pray for regular bail by raising all points and the learned court below will pass appropriate order on its own merit without being prejudiced by this order.
