ORDER

21.04.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P for the State on the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners namely 1. Naresh Bind, 2. Arvind Bind and 3. Bocha Bind @ Bicha Bind @ Dhanveer Kumar, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with Kako (Bhelawar) P.S case no. 110/2026 for offence U/Ss-126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2) and 3/5 B.N.S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no bail application either regular or anticipatory has been ever moved either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application and the petitioners have got criminal antecedent of one case in which they are on bail. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners and all the sections are bailable except section 109(1) of B.N.S. It is further submitted that the petitioners' sister had lodged a case bearing Jehanabad Mahila P.S. Case no. 59/2018 under POCSO Act against the informant of this case and this case has been filed against the petitioners to save from that case. At last prayer for anticipatory bail has been made.

On the other hand, the learned P.P. has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Niranjana Kumar is that on 14.03.2026 at about 08 o' clock at night when the informant's brother Suraj Kumar was returning to his house from Jehanabad by his

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motorcycle and as soon as he reached near the house of Dina Bind, some altercation occurred between the informant's brother and the co-accused Praveen Bind regarding passing of motorcycle in which the informant's brother was assaulted by the co-accused Praveen Bind, thereafter on information on 112, police came and pacified the matter. It is further alleged that after going of dial-112, the petitioners along with co-accused persons began to commit Marpit and the co-accused Praveen Bind assaulted the informant on his head by means of iron rod due to which blood was oozing out and he became unconscious. The petitioner Arvind Bind and co-accused Dhanesar Kumar assaulted the informant's father by means of rod causing injury on his head, forehead and eye. It is further alleged that the petitioner Bochwa Bind snatched Rs. 5,000/-, mobile and the co-accused Praveen Bind snatched gold locket from the informant's father. Thereafter, the injured were brought to Sadar hospital, Jehanabad for treatment. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. From perusal of record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioners. As per injury reports attached to the case diary, the doctor has found simple injury on the persons of the injured caused by hard blunt object.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **allowed** and in case of their arrest or surrender before the learned lower court within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the accused/petitioners 1. Naresh Bind, 2. Arvind Bind and 3. Bocha Bind @ Bicha Bind @ Dhanveer Kumar are ordered to be released on bail furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned subject to conditions laid down u/s/-482(2) of B.N.S.S.
