ORDER

13.05.2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned P. P. for the State on the regular bail petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner Bipin Chaudhary, who is in custody since 30.03.2026, in connection with, Hulasganj P. S. Case No. 98/2026 for offence U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1) and 3(5) of B. N. S.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent, he has committed no offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no B. P. or A. B. P. has been filed by the petitioner either in this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna nor the same is pending in any court and the petitioner has no criminal history. He is in custody since 30.03.2026. At last, it is submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, the learned P. P. opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

Stated in brief, the prosecution case as per the written application of the informant Pintu Das is that on 18.03.2026 at about 7:30 P.M., when he went to pacify the quarrel which was going between the petitioner and the co-accused Sunil Chaudhary, in the meantime, the petitioner began to assault the informant by means of rod due to which the informant

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sustained injury thereafter co-accused Sunil Chaudhary also assaulted the informant by means of *Pasuli* due to which he sustained injury on his hand. Thereafter the informant was brought to PHC, Hulasganj. Accordingly, the FIR has been registered.

Perused the record. It appears from final injury report attached to the case diary that the doctor has found simple injury on the person of the injured and the injury is on non-vital part of the body caused by hard and blunt substance. As per para-44 of the case diary, the petitioner has got no criminal history and he is in custody since 30.03.2026.

Considering the above noted facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this bail petition is hereby **allowed** and the accused/petitioner Bipin Chaudhary, is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
