

**Court of Addl. Sessions Judge -I , Jehanabad**  
**B.P No. 301/2026**  
**Shakurabad PS Case No. 29/2026**  
**( Md. Bare and another v/s State of Bihar )**

**Order**

**12.05.2026 –**

An application for bail has been filed on behalf of accused petitioners namely, 1. Md. Bare and 2. Sanni Kumar, who are in custody since 11.04.2026 and 13.04.2026 respectively, in connection with Shakurabad PS Case No. 29/2026, under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 121(1), 121(2), 221, 132, 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 74, 324(3) B.N.S. has been pressed today for hearing.

It has been submitted by the Ld. Counsel on behalf of the accused petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have no concern with the alleged crime rather they have been falsely implicated at instance of sworn of local chaukidar. Further, submitted that no doubt the petitioners are named in the alleged crime but, petitioners never participated in the alleged crime and allegation against the petitioners is vague and general in which they have been made accused. Further, submitted that earlier, a bail petition had been filed on behalf of petitioners in the Court of Ld. Sri Aarav Jain, J.M.F.C. after hearing, which was rejected on 17.04.2026, except this there is no anticipatory or regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this Learned Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna and not the same is pending anywhere. Further, submitted that other co-accused persons have been granted bail in this case. Further, submitted that petitioners are ready to furnish the bail bond to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court. Petitioners carry no criminal antecedent in their credit. Petitioners are in custody since 11.04.2026 and 13.04.2026 respectively. Accordingly, prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioners on bail .

On the other hand, learned P.P. opposed the prayer of bail .

Prosecution story, in brief, is that in the light of Hon'ble High Court's order passed in Cr.W.J.C. No. 820/2023 and notification 158/vidhi dated 27.01.2026, on 28.01.2026 informant alongwith Government Officers and Government Officials started making announcement to vacate the land of applicant. Thereafter, accused persons started agitating the crowd and then all the FIR named accused persons and 35 unknown persons including the petitioners attacked on the Government Officials, due to which they received injuries. Accused persons also damaged the Government vehicles. In this way, all the accused persons obstructed to perform their official duty and disobeyed the order

of Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

Heard and perused the lower court record alongwith case diary. From the perusal of case record, it transpires that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners of assaulting and obstructing Police Personnel in the discharge of their official duties. Upon perusal of the injury report of the injured persons, it appears that the injuries have been opined to be simple in nature by the doctor. It further transpires that the name of the petitioners were disclosed by the Mahal chaukidar.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as well as clean antecedent of petitioners, I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners, namely, 1. Md. Bare and 2. Sanni Kumar on bail. Hence, accused petitioners are hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. trial Court along with further condition that one of the bailors shall be their family member/close relative of the petitioners, who will file an undertaking as to how they are related with the petitioners with another condition that petitioners will file an undertaking that they will never indulge in similar offence in future and shall cooperate in the investigation.
