ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition was filed under section 482 of BNSS on behalf of accused petitioner who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Jehanabad Mahila P.S. Case No.67/25** for the offence **under section 351(2), 352, 85, 75, 3(5) of BNS and ¼ D.P. Act** which is pending in the court of **Ld. SDJM, Jehanabad**.

The prosecution case as stated in the written report of the informant Nisha Kumari in brief is that she got married with Awadhesh Kumar 6 years ago. After marriage from the very beginning her husband has not established relationship with her like husband and wife. Her husband Awadhesh Kumar, elder brother-in-law Sunil Kumar and mother-in-law Leela Devi demand 20,00,000/- rupees and a four-wheeler. Her father has already died and her mother is not capable to provide it. They all torture her in various way and she was asked to live in her Maika. She is abused and threatened for life of her brother and mother. She is driven out of home by assault. Her husband is Junior Engineer in Water Resources department at Nawada but he does not want to keep her there. Her elder brother-in-law Sunil Kumar says that he will commit rape and tease her.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner submitted that accused petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence whatsoever. He submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He submits that petitioner is elder brother-in-law of informant and resides outside the district because he is A.S.I in Excise Department posted at Shekhpura District but he has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that the informant is in habit of filing false case and earlier she has filed Jehanabad Mahila P.S. case no. 54/2019 against her husband and elder brother-in-law in which Ld. Trial Court acquitted both of them on the basis of compromise. He submits that in that case witnesses including mother of the informant completely denied the allegation of dowry demand. He submits that petitioner is in government Job. Accordingly, it is prayed to grant anticipatory bail to this accused-petitioner.

Learned APP opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Heard the argument and perused the record. Perusal of record shows that petitioner is elder brother-in-law of informant. The tendency to implicate entire family in matrimonial cases has been recognized even by our Hon'ble Supreme Court. Considering all the facts and circumstances, it is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the Court below/concerned police within fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) of BNSS.
