Chandan Yadav v/s State of Bihar

An application for bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Chandan Yadav, who is in custody since 28-03-2026 in connection with Barabar Tourism P.S. Case No. 12/2026 lodged under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 352, 109(1), 132, 303(2), 3(5) B.N.S. has been pressed today for hearing .

Heard Mr. Bhushan Prasad Learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Shardanand Kumar, learned P.P.

Prosecution case as per typed information of informant PASI Sonu Kumar, in brief, is that on 29.01.2026 at about 05:00 pm he along with his associates proceeds from P.S. and started vehicle checking near Shanti Kuti. During course of vehicle checking, at about 06:00 pm noticed that one motorcycle boarded with two persons one man and another lady is coming from Hathiya Bore, On seeing police, signaled him to stop, on seeing this they started fleeing away, but after chase they caught and video prepared. On being asked they disclosed his name as Bhim Yadav and his wife namely Anita Devi and on being asked about fleeing and documents of the vehicle, started abusing him and called 5 to 6 unknown persons and with intention to kill attacked on him. Accused persons assaulted him with fists and slaps and thrashed him in the field. Thereafter, after forming unlawful assembly broken his hand and snatched pistol and Jeela Butt no. 411 containing 07 live cartridges from his possession and fled away lifting his motorcycle. Bearing registration no. BR02BG4031.

It has been submitted on behalf of the accused petitioner by his learned counsel that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has come during investigation in confessional statement of co-accused. Petitioner carries no criminal antecedent in his credit. Co-accused Ashok Kumar has already allowed bail vide order dated 29.4.26 passed in B.P. No. 163/26 by this court. Petitioner was not apprehended at the spot and implicated in the present case on mere suspicion at the instance of his enemies. Petitioner is in custody since 28-03-2026. Accordingly, prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioner bail.

On the other hand, Learned P.P. has though opposed the prayer for bail .

Heard and perused the case record as well as case diary. Petitioner is not named in the

FIR. It is evident that allegation against the petitioner is composite in nature. From the perusal of para 93 of the case diary it appears that informant/injured received two injuries as 1. pain and swelling in elbow joint and 2. pain and swelling above right eye on his persons. It is evident that doctor has found injury no. 1 pain and swelling in elbow joint grievous in nature, which is not mentioned as dangerous to life. Petitioner carries no criminal antecedent in his credit which has specifically been mentioned in para no. 3 of the bail petition. It is evident that co-accused has already enlarged on bail earlier by this court. Petitioner is in custody since 28.03.2026.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as well clean antecedent of the petitioner and also incarceration period of the petitioner , I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail. Hence, accused petitioner is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 15,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. trial Court along with further condition that one of the bailor shall be his family member of the petitioner, who will file an affidavit as to how he/she is related with the petitioner with another condition that petitioner will file an undertaking that he will never indulge in similar offence in future and cooperate during the investigation.
