ORDER

Dated:30.07.2026

1. This anticipatory bail petition was filed on behalf of above named petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Jehanabad P.S Case No. 648/2026 registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2) 3(5) BNS and section 27 of Arms Act.
2. The prosecution case as stated in the written report the informant Sachin Kumar in brief is that on 04.07.2026 at about 03:00 P.M he was going from Rampur towards Raja Bazar by his motorcycle and when he reached near Ravi Sweets then all of a sudden Santosh Kumar @Guddan Sharma, Gyan Bhushan Kushwaha @ Pintu, Raushan Kumar, Manish Sharma, Shashank Kumar, Shivam Kumar @ Banti Aryan, Ajit Kumar, Arun Kumar and seven unknown persons armed with iron rod, knife, hockey stick and lathi stopped him. Butan Kumar pushed him of the motorcycle and made him fall. Butan Kumar assaulted him by means of rod, Pintu assaulted him by means of hockey, Raushan assaulted him by means of lathi indiscriminately. Due to assault he received severe injury. Butan and Raushan fired gun shot and threatened people who are present at the place of incident not to help him. When police came they fled away.

3. It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that they are innocent and have committed no offence rather they have been falsely implicated in this case. The allegations levelled against them are false and baseless. There is no criminal antecedent. It is therefore, prayed that the petitioners may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.
4. Learned A.P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.
5. Heard the argument and perused the record. Perusal of record shows that the case diary is available on record. Injury report is available on record and nature of injuries inflicted upon the injured are simple in nature. There is case and counter case between the parties. A compromise petition was filed on record. The injured appeared and on being asked they supported the factum of compromise.
6. Considering all these facts and circumstances, it is hereby ordered that in the event of surrender or arrest before the Court below/concerned police within fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners will be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/police subject to the condition under the provision of section 482(2) of BNSS. **It is further directed that the accused-petitioners will remain physically present on every date before trial court and if they fail to appear physically for two consecutive dates without proper explanation, the trial court will be at liberty to cancel their bail bond.**
7. A copy of this order be sent to the concerned court.
