ORDER

1. Applicants 1. Rajaram Sharma 2. Sanju Devi 3. Saurabh Sharma and 4. Arjun Sharma have filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending their arrest in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per FIR registered on 22.11.2025 are that accused persons including applicants tried to set ablaze the sister of the informant who was married with Bhim Sharma in November 2014.
3. Ld. Counsel for applicants has submitted that the applicants are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Applicants have no criminal antecedent. Entire prosecution story is false and concocted. There is dispute between husband and wife and there was no participation of

these applicants in this case. Applicants are living separately. Applicants are relative of the victim and they had no concern with the alleged occurrence. Other co-accused have been granted bail by this Court. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicants are ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if they are enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and C.D.
6. Applicants are uncle, sister, cousin and brother respectively of the husband of the victim. Witnesses have stated that relationship between victim and the husband was not cordial. Son of the victim has stated that she had self immolated after dispute with his father. Incident is dated 21.11.2025. Victim was discharged from the PMCH on 05.01.2026 and died in her maika on 13.01.2026. Nothing incriminating material is available in the case diary against the applicants. They have clean antecedent. No material is available on the record that applicants will flee away from the process of law and tamper with the evidence if they are enlarged on pre-arrest bail. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of applicants for pre-arrest bail is accepted. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicants shall be enlarged on bail on their executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand)

with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. Court below/Arresting officer with further conditions that;

(a) Applicants shall cooperate with the investigation and make themselves available for interrogation whenever required;

(b) Applicants shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;

(c) Applicants shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;

(d) Applicants shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and shall not change their residence till the final disposal of the case till further orders;

7. A.B.A No. 124 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
