ORDER

1. Applicants Badal Mandal in ABA No. 173/2026 and Banarasi Mandal alias Banarsi Prasad Mandal and Munni Devi in ABA No. 174/2026 are seeking pre-arrest bail in aforesaid complaint case apprehending their arrest.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per complaint petition filed on 05.01.2019 are that the complainant was married with Badal Mandal on 22.04.2011. Banarsi Mandal and Munni Devi are her father in-law and mother in-law respectively. A baby girl was born out of the said wedlock. Family members of her husband started torturing her for

giving birth to a female child. They demanded Rs. 5 lacs from her and when the said demand was not met complainant was thrown out from the matrimonial home on 08.12.2018.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicants has submitted that the applicants are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that a settlement has been arrived between the parties before Mediation Centre DLSA Khagaria and applicants are ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if they are enlarged on anticipatory bail.
4. Ld. P.P. for State has submitted that if the parties have settled their dispute amicably then this Court may pass appropriate order in this regard.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and L.C.R.
6. At the request of the parties aforesaid two bail applications were referred for mediation. This Court has received report dated 21.04.2026 of the Mediation Centre, DLSA, Khagaria stating that parties have settled their dispute amicably and as per settlement, they would file joint petition u/S. 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act before the Ld. Family Court and cooperate each other in disposal of pending cases against each other. In view of aforesaid settlement arrived between the parties prayer of pre-arrest bail of Badal Mandal in ABA No. 173/2026 and Banarsi Mandal alias Banarsi Prasad Mandal & Munni Devi in ABA No. 174/2026 is accepted. In the event of arrest

or surrender within six weeks from today applicants shall be enlarged on bail on their executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the ld. Court below/Arresting officer.

7. A.B.A No. 173 of 2026 and A.B.A. No.174/2026 are hereby allowed.
