ORDER

1. Applicant Chandan Kumar has filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending his arrest in the aforesaid complaint case.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per complaint petition filed in aforesaid complaint case are that complainant was married with the applicant on 14.06.2023 according to Hindu Rites and Ceremonies. After few days of marriage her husband and his family members started demanding Rs. 1 lakh. She was being regularly tortured by them.
3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that the applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence. Applicant has no

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criminal antecedent. Complainant is not ready to lead conjugal life with applicant but applicant is ready to live with his wife. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicants are ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if they are enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application.
6. Parties are present in person. Conciliation efforts made by Mediation Centre have fructified and parties are residing together. Complainant has no serious grievance against the applicant/husband except that he does not give much time to her. Applicant has assured that he will arrange all necessities as per his capacity and also will help her to continue her studies. It appears that parties have settled into their life and for their better future no steps should be taken to jeopardize their relationship. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of applicant for pre-arrest bail is accepted. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicant shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the ld. Court below/Arresting officer.

7. A.B.A No. 185 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
