ORDER

1. Applicant Smt. Manju Devi has filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending her arrest in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per F.I.R. registered on 24.09.2025 are that informant who is the Branch Manager of Bihar Gramin Bank made a written complaint to the SHO alleging that applicant had taken loan of Rs. 3 lacs on 03.12.2008 on collateral security of her land but she sold the same without informing the Bank.
3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that the applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence. Applicant has no

criminal antecedent. Applicant has paid amount of Rs. 5,62,537/- to the Bank and a photocopy of payment receipt is attached with the bail application. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if she is enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and C.D.
6. Applicant has filed deposit receipt of Rs. 5,62,537/- dated 04.02.2026 of the Bihar Gramin Bank. Case diary also mentions the payment of aforesaid amount. Applicant is a lady. Prima facie a case for pre-arrest bail is made out. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of applicant for pre-arrest bail is accepted. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicant shall be enlarged on bail on her executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the ld. Court below/Arresting officer with further conditions that;
 - (a) Applicant shall cooperate with the investigation and make herself available for interrogation whenever required;
 - (b) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;

- (c) Applicant shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;
- (d) Applicant shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and shall not change her residence till the final disposal of the case till further orders;
7. A.B.A No. 267 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
