**ORDER**

1. Applicants 1. Rajo Sharma 2. Kaushal Kumar 3. Naveen Kumar 4. Mukesh Sharma and 5. Balmiki Sharma alias Bali have filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending their arrest in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per F.I.R. registered on 03.02.2026 are that on 01.02.2026 at about 3:30 p.m. applicants/accused and two other unknown persons assaulted him and when his son Shivam came for his rescue he was attacked by Rajo Sharma with knife. Kaushal Kumar was loading bullet in threeknot and hit on his right palm with

butt of three knot. Informant has alleged that Rajo Sharma was keeping grudge against him due to defeat in Mukhiya election.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicants has submitted that the applicants are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Applicant No. 1 has one, applicant Nos. 2 and 3 has two, applicant No. 5 has three criminal antecedent and applicant No. 4 has no criminal antecedent. Applicants have no concern with the alleged occurrence. No case is made out u/S. 109(1) of BNS against the applicants. Applicant No. 3 had lodged an F.I.R. against informant's brother. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicants are ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if they are enlarged on anticipatory bail.
4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State and Ld. Counsel for informant have strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and C.D.
6. There is direct allegation of applicant No. 1/Rajo Sharma and applicant No. 2/Kaushal Kumar to assault son of the informant. Injured has received head injury which has been opined as grievous in nature. Applicant No. 1 and 2 have also criminal antecedent. Against other applicants there is no specific allegation. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer for pre-arrest bail of applicant Nos. applicant No. 1/Rajo Sharma and applicant No. 2/Kaushal Kumar is declined whereas prayer for pre-arrest bail of applicant No.3/Naveen Kumar, applicant No.4/Mukesh Sharma and applicant No.5/Balmiki

Sharma alias Bali is accepted. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicant Nos. 3, 4 and 5 shall be enlarged on bail on their executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. Court below/Arresting officer with further conditions that;

- (a) Applicant Nos. 3, 4 and 5 shall cooperate with the investigation and make themselves available for interrogation whenever required;
  - (b) Applicant No. 3, 4 and 5 shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
  - (c) Applicant Nos. 3, 4 and 5 shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;
  - (d) Applicants Nos. 3, 4 and 5 shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and shall not change their residence till the final disposal of the case till further orders;
7. A.B.A No. 281 of 2026 is hereby partly allowed.
