ORDER

1. Vide instant order, I propose to dispose of aforesaid application for regular bail filed on behalf of the accused Rajeet Sah, who is stated to be in judicial custody since 05.01.2026 in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per FIR registered on 01.01.2015 are that informant got registered the aforesaid F.I.R. stating that she was married with the applicant on 14.02.2001 and they are blessed with a son. She has alleged that she was regularly tortured by her husband

and his family members. She has stated that on 14.12.2014 her husband/applicant performed second marriage. Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 13.04.2017 passed in Criminal Misc. No. 8913/17 granted provisional anticipatory bail with direction to the applicant to pay Rs. 2000/- per month as maintenance to his wife and son.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No case is made out against the applicant. Applicant had been granted provisional bail by Hon'ble High Court subject to condition that applicant shall pay a sum of Rs. 2000/- per month as maintenance to his wife and minor son but applicant could not fulfill the terms and condition of the Hon'ble High Court due to poor financial condition. Allegation of cruelty is omnibus. Ld. Counsel has also submitted that applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if he is enlarged on bail.
4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for state has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and L.C.R.
6. Ld. Trial Court cancelled the bail bonds of the applicant vide order dated 06.12.2025 due to non compliance of order of Hon'ble High Court passed in Criminal Misc. Case No. 8913/2017 and he was taken into custody. During arguments Ld. Counsel for applicant has

submitted that applicant is not in position to make any payment to the informant/wife. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail.

7. B.A. No. 290 of 2026 is hereby dismissed.
