ORDER

1. Applicant Manish Kumar has filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending his arrest in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per F.I.R. registered on 20.02.2026 are that informant is an ASI and he received an information that applicant/accused and another persons were firing bullets with country made pistol on the crowd in village Bhutouli Malpa, Ward No. 15. During investigation it was found that earlier also he used to threaten people by brandishing weapons.
3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that the applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence. All alleged sections are not applicable

against the applicant. No illegal weapon or incriminating material was recovered from the possession and house of the applicant. The entire allegation is general and there is no independent witness mentioned who has clearly identified the applicant committing the alleged act. Applicant is young boy aged about 19 years having clean antecedent. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if he is enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and C.D.
6. Applicant is a youth of 19 years. There is no eye witness to the incident. There is no public witness to the incident as well. Nobody has received injury. Case diary does not mention any antecedent of the applicant. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, more particularly age and first incident of the applicant, prayer of pre-arrest bail of the applicant is **accepted**. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicant shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. Court below/Arresting officer with further conditions that;
 - (a) Applicant shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available for interrogation whenever required;
 - (b) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;

- (c) Applicant shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;
- (d) Applicant shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and shall not change his residence till the final disposal of the case till further orders;
7. A.B.A No. 304 of 2026 is hereby **allowed**.
