ORDER

1. Applicants 1. Chandan Kumar, 2. Pawan Das and 3. Phul Kumari Devi have filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending their arrest in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per F.I.R. registered on 16.05.2024 are that on 14.05.2024 minor daughter of the informant had gone to study in her school where she was kidnapped by the applicants/accused persons.
3. Ld. Counsel for applicants has submitted that the applicants are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Ld. Counsel has further

submitted that the applicant No.2 (Pawan Das) and applicant No. 3 (Phul Kumari Devi) are the father and mother of applicant No.1 (Chandan Kumar) respectively. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that the informant and the applicants are immediate neighbours. The applicants have been named in the FIR on the basis of suspicion. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicants are ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if they are enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and C.D.
6. Victim has been recovered. In her statement u/S. 183 of BNSS, she has stated that she has married with the applicant No. 1 and they have a five months old baby boy also. She has stated nothing incriminating against the applicants. No purpose shall be served by putting them behind bar. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of applicants for pre-arrest bail is accepted. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicants shall be enlarged on bail on their executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the ld. Court below/Arresting officer with further conditions that;

- (a) Applicants shall cooperate with the investigation and make themselves available for interrogation whenever required;
 - (b) Applicants shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
 - (c) Applicants shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;
 - (d) Applicants shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and shall not change their residence till the final disposal of the case till further orders;
7. A.B.A No. 420 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
