ORDER

1. Applicant Pankaj Kumar @ Pankaj Kumar Singh has filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending his arrest in the aforesaid F.I.R.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per F.I.R. registered on 12.09.2022 are that on 11.09.2022 accused persons including applicant attacked the camp and office of the S.P. Singla, a construction company. They tried to set on fire the camp and office. Accused persons badly assaulted staff of the aforesaid company. They set on fire motorcycles

and damaged all heavy and light vehicles including hiwa. Computer, AC, Fan, T.V., Chair, Mobile, C.C.T.V., Harddisk, SSD Card and Laptops were taken away.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that the applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged in the FIR. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to local village politics. Other co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by the Honb'le Patna High Court and case of the applicant is similar and identical. Ld. counsel also submitted that there is one more case against applicant. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if he is enlarged on anticipatory bail.
4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and C.D..
6. Applicant is named accused of the FIR. He was a member of the mob who ransacked the office, Camp, vehicles of the construction company. Computer apparatus were also taken away. Injured witnesses have taken the name of the applicant. He has admitted his one antecedent. Investigation against the applicant is pending. In

view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the applicants on bail.

7. A.B.A No. 492 of 2026 is hereby dismissed.
