ORDER

1. Applicant Ram Udesb Yadav @ Gopi has filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending his arrest.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per F.I.R. registered on 19.06.2020 are that on 15.06.2020 at about 10:00 PM informant was sleeping in her house with children, suddenly she heard sound of some person jumping over the boundary. There were seven persons and they assaulted her daughter. Her daughter received injury on her head and two fingers, whereas informant had also received injuries on her head and shoulder. Cash and some jewelry were also taken away by them.

3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that the applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence. All alleged sections are bailable in nature except Sections 307, 326, 379 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that co-accused Deo Narayan Yadav and Dilip Yadav have already been enlarged on regular bail by this Court earlier and other co-accused Laxmi Yadav, Ram Lalit Yadav and Ram Vinay Yadav have been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Cr.Misc. No. 14258/2021 and order dt. 22.12.2021 and case of this applicant stands on better footing. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this court if he is enlarged on anticipatory bail.
4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application and L.C.R.
6. No specific role of the applicant has been ascribed in the FIR. Three similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court vide Cr.Misc. No. 14258 of 2021. FIR is very old. Applicant has no criminal antecedent. Custodial interrogation has not been sought. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of applicant for pre-arrest bail is accepted. In the event of arrest in connection with Alauli P.S. Case No 177/2020 or surrender within six weeks from today applicant shall be enlarged on bail on his executing

a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. Court below/

Arresting officer with further conditions that;

- (a) Applicant shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available for interrogation whenever required;
- (b) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
- (c) Applicant shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;
- (d) Applicant shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and shall not change his/her/their residence till the final disposal of the case till further orders;

7. A.B.A No. 542 of 2026 is hereby **allowed**.
