ORDER

1. Applicant Md. Haider has filed aforesaid application u/S. 482 of B.N.S.S. apprehending his arrest.
2. Briefly stated facts of the case as per FIR registered on 21.08.2022 is that informant made a written complaint to the S.P. Khagaria alleging her kidnapping on 13.06.2022 by applicant along with other co-accused persons to compel her for marriage.
3. Ld. Counsel for applicant has submitted that the applicant is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. Ld. counsel further submitted that there was love affair between applicant and victim and at the pressure of parents and family members this false case has been brought against this applicant. Ld. counsel also submitted that the

occurrence took place on 13.06.2022 and the case was lodged on 21.08.2022 so there is inordinate delay in lodging of FIR. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by this Court if he is enlarged on anticipatory bail.

4. Conversely, Ld. P.P. for State has strongly opposed the bail application.
5. Heard. Perused the bail application, C.D. and L.C.R.
6. Victim is major. In investigation it has come that there was an affair with the applicant and victim. Alleged incident is dated 13.06.2022 and FIR was registered on 21.08.2022. There is no explanation of this delay. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of applicants for pre-arrest bail is accepted. In the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today applicant shall be enlarged on bail on their executing a personal bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. Court below/Arresting officer with further conditions that;

- (a) Applicant shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available for interrogation whenever required;
- (b) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
- (c) Applicant shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not to play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;
- (d) Applicant shall at the time of execution of bond, furnish the address to the investigating officer and the court concerned and

shall not change his residence till the final disposal of the case
till further orders;

7. A.B.A No.564 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
