ORDER

20.05.2026

1) In B.A. No- 548/2026, the petitioner-accused, namely, Chhotu Kumar has applied for regular bail inasmuch as he has been in judicial custody since 04.04.2026. In A.B.A. No- 999/2026, the petitioner-accused, namely, Rahul Kumar has applied for pre-arrest bail inasmuch as he has been apprehending his arrest. Both the bail applications have arisen out of the common P.S. bearing Naokothi P.S Case No- 57/2026, registered for the offence punishable u/ss-103(1), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 ("B.N.S"), pending in the court of Sri Pappu Kumar Pandit, Ld. J.M.F.C., Begusarai.

2) The prosecution story is based on the written report of one, Mantun Jha (informant), in which he has submitted that on 30.03.2026, his son was present at home, then at around 02:00 PM, his friend-Rajnish Kumar came to his house by bullet motorcycle, and took his son with him on his motorcycle, but son of the

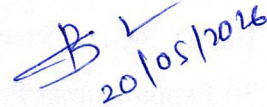
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informant did not return to home. As per informant, his son was called on his mobile, but he remained trace-less, and when he was called on his mobile. After sometime, when the connection through mobile was made, the son of informant was crying in pain from other end. As per informant, the co-villagers of the informant have informed the informant that his son is lying injured at a secluded place, his hands and legs were tied, and there were thrashing marks on his head, hand, and chest by bricks, and danda. As per informant, when the informant, and his family members went to the indicated place, they found the dead body of his son. As per informant, four (4) days prior to the incident, the accused-Aako Singh @ Ram Kumar Singh, and his two (2) sons, Gaurav Kumar, and Saurav Kumar issued threat to commit murder of the son of the informant. As per informant, the above said incident of murder has been committed by the accomplices of the above named accused persons, namely, Vivek Kumar @ Natwar, Rahul Kumar (petitioner in A.B.A. No-999/2026), Chhotu Kumar (petitioner in B.A. No-548/2026). As per informant, all of the above said accused persons have committed the murder of the son of the informant.

3) Ld. counsels for the parties have argued that though the names of the petitioner-accused have been mentioned in the FIR, however no specific allegation against them have been levelled. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners have further argued that this is not a case of conspiracy, neither the police has registered the case/FIR for hatching the conspiracy.

4) Today, the case diary has been submitted in the court. Ld. Counsel for the parties wants to peruse the case diary, for that purpose, Ld. Counsel is seeking two (2) days' time. In view of above submissions, put up this case on 22.05.2026 for hearing on merits.
