15-05-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Ajad Alam 2. Najir Alam 3. Avesh Alam 4. Sarfaraj alam 5. Sanower Alam 6. Nurjabi, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bahadurganj P.S. case no.-496/2025, u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant is that on 19.12.2025 at 10:00 AM all of the accused persons including these petitioners came with stick and other weapons assaulted the informant and his family members and broke the informant's Tubwel and fance. When the informant protest all the accused persons tied with a rope and assaulted the informant duet to which informant has got pain in his body. When Ahmad Hussain came to save her then they also assaulted him. Accused Sarfaraj and Sanowar Alam entered the house during the assault and took away two bhar of gold and ten bhar of silver and Cash Rs. 20,000/-. On the basis of written report of the informant Bahadurganj P.S. Case NO. 496/2025 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case unnecessarily. The victim of this case Arti Kumari and petitioner no. 01 Vikas Kumar Karmakar love each other. Both are adults and both have married of their own free will. The FIR is u/s 87, 3(5) of BNS which are not attracted with the petitioners. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has clean antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

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5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation against these petitioners is that they came on the door of the informant and assaulted her brutally. When Ahmad Hussain came to save her then they also assaulted him. From perusal of case diary it transpires that during investigation the police has given benefit of section 35(3) BNSS to the petitioners. After investigation the police has submitted charge-sheet and accordingly cognizance has been taken against the petitioners. Considering the facts stated above I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has clean antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioners namely, 1. Ajad Alam 2. Najir Alam 3. Avesh Alam 4. Sarfaraj alam 5. Sanower Alam 6. Nurjabi are hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from of receipt of the copy of this order in learned Trial Court, on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS.
