22-04-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner namely, Chandan Paswan, Petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2026 in connection with Kishanganj (Cyber) P. S. Case No. 01/2026, registered u/s 316(2), 318(2), 319(2), 61(2) BNS and 66(D) It Act. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of informant is that informant Jio Payment bank account no. 000520391306611 had taken over by the accused persons through deception and manipulation and money transactions were conducted by the accused without his knowledge due to which his account had been put on hold by the bank. On the basis of written report of the informant Kishanganj (Cyber) P. S. Case No. 01/2026 was registered.

3. Apart from pleading innocence and false implication learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence. Entire allegation alleged in the FIR by the informant is totally false, fictitious, concocted. The case has been compromised between both the parties and a separate compromise and permission petition filed in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Kishanganj. Nothing incriminating articles has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. Nothing has been done by the petitioners as alleged in the FIR fact is that the petitioners borrowed money from informant for some work and pay back to during the fixed time but unfortunately petitioners failed to pay said money for unavoidable circumstance at the fixed time and so this dispute arisen between both the parties and this case lodged against the petitioners. Petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2026.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

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5. From perusal of the record it transpires that there is allegation against this petitioner that he forcibly and fraudulently obtained Jio Payment Bank account no. 000520391306611 of the informant and got illegally transactions from the said account due to which his account has been put on hold by the bank. From perusal of seizure list it transpires that various ATM card of different banks and pass book has been recovered from the possession of petitioner. From perusal of case diary and statement of bank account attached with the case diary it transpires that the petitioner and other co-accused persons have made various illegally transactions through various bank accounts. After investigation the police has submitted charge-sheet and Ld. Trial Court has taken cognizance against this petitioners. Allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature.

6. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and nature and gravity of allegations, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner. As such, prayer for bail made on behalf of petitioners namely, Chandan Paswan is hereby **rejected**.
