04-04-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner namely, Md. Mujahir, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint case no. 248/2026, registered u/s 498(A) of IPC. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case in short is that complainant married with Md. Abasar Alam on 20.03.2003 as per Muslim rites and customs. At the time of marriage informants brothers gave them silver ornaments and other household items as per their capacity. After sometimes complainant was being tortured, abused and assaulted by all the accused persons including this petitioner and pressured her brothers to transfer land or get her divorced. Under pressure, complainant brothers were registered 13 Decimals of land in his name and he has been living there since and again after sometimes all of the accused persons including this petitioner abused and assaulted her for one motorcycle. When the complainant denied to fulfill the demand of dowry, all the accused persons including this petitioner assaulted her, snatched her ornaments and ousted her from their house and kept all her belongings.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence. Petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The applicants are law abiding citizens with clean antecedents and permanent residence, having deep social roots in the community. This petitioner is relative of complainant's husband and has been falsely implicated with omnibus allegations without any specific overact. The covid-19 pandemic also played a major part in the petitioner's non-appearance before the Ld. Court. The Ld. Court issued summons, but no service report exists to show that the summons were ever served upon the applicants.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.
5. From perusal of record it transpires that the petitioner is in-laws of the complainant and there is allegation that he along with other co-accused persons assaulted the complainant for dowry and ousted her from their house. From perusal of the case record it transpires that this petitioner is relative of complainant's husband of this case. Dispute in this case is matrimonial in nature. From para 03 of the bail petition petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances , the petitioner namely, Md. Mujahir is hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from of receipt of the copy of this order in learned Trial Court, on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS.
