29-07-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner namely, Farid Alam, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bahadurganj P.S. case no.-311/ 2025, registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 191(2), 190, 76, 303(2), 109(1), 351(1), 352 of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case as per written application of the informant Anju Parveen has that on 08.07.2025 at 06:00 PM due to domestic dispute all of the accused persons including these petitioners assaulted her and her family members. The accused persons abused and assaulted her and when her mother tried to save her all of the accused persons including these petitioner also assaulted her mother and Farid Alam allegedly attacked her mother from behind with a spade with intent to kill due to which she sustained serious head injuries and tore her clothes and snatched five bhari of silver ornaments. When her elder sister roshan tried to help she was also beaten, her tooth was broken and an attempt was made to strangulate her. The accused persons threatened to kill all of them with spade and thrown their bodies into the river if anyone tried to intervene. After halla villagers came their and taken way them to the hospital for treatment. On the basis of written application of the informant Bahadurganj P.S. Case NO. 311/2025 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence. Allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are totally false, fictitious, concocted and far from truth. Civil dispute between both the parties. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to land dispute. Allegations against the petitioner are omnibus. All sections are bailable except 76, 303(2), 109(1) BNS. The allegations of 76 BNS is not specific against the petitioner. Allegation U/s 303(2) BNS is imaginary as far

from truth. The Petitioner's father Md. Sultan had also filed a case bearing Bahadurganj P.S. Case NO. 312/2025 against the informant and his associates.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail and prayed to dispose the anticipatory bail petition.

5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation against this petitioner that he abused and assaulted the informant and thrown her on the ground. When her mother came to save her then accused persons also assaulted her and torn her cloths. They took silver moon of five bhar from the mother of the informant. There is specific allegation against Farid Alam is that he assaulted with spade on the head of the mother of the informant due to which she sustained injury on her head and she became unconscious. When sisters of the informant Roshan came to save then accused persons also assaulted her and broken her teeth. From perusal of injury report attached with the case dowry it transpires that mother of the informant has sustained injury of right side of scalp size 2"x2"x1". Injury of Roshan is blunt head trauma with loss of consciousness for 10 minutes and injury of Anju Parween is bruise on left arm and injuries are simple in nature. Allegations against this petitioner is of assault of the informant and her family members due to which four persons have sustained injuries. Considering the nature of allegation, it is not fit for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and nature of allegation, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and as such the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner Farid Alam is hereby **rejected**.
