20-05-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Pappu, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kishanganj P.S. case no.-59/2026, registered u/s 318(4), 316(2), 338, 111(2), 61(2) of BNS and 3, 4 of Bihar Banned Lottery Act. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. prosecution story as per self statement of Abhishek Kumar Ranjan, S.H.O., Kishanganj P.S. is that on 22.01.2026 at about 18:05 PM he proceeded from police station regarding collection of information. In the meantime he got secret information that in Kasera Patti in the house of Md. Rahim a person namely Nasim gang syndicate of lottery supply and he he present their. On this information he informed to his senior officials and with other police officers and with raiding party he reached near that Kasera Patti at about 09:35 PM. During raid five persons Md. Nasim, Md. Shakir, Ali Khan, Suraj Kumar and Krishna Mahto were found present and there was huge quantity of lottery ticket and cash was kept in front of them. During search different type of lottery tickets total valued Rs. 16,07,500/- was recovered, 26 notes of 500 rupees, 15 notes of 200, 05 notes of 100, 23 notes of 50 rupees, 09 notes of 20 rupees total Rs. 23894/- and some other lottery tickets were also recovered. One mobile oppo company was recovered from possession of Nasim, one Samsung mobile was recovered from Ali Khan, one realme company mobile was recovered from Suraj Kumar Gaur and one plus mobile was recovered from Krishna Mahto. During interrogation Md. Nasim disclosed that he runs business of lottery and Md. Akbar and Seru supplies him lottery tickets and he used to sell them. He also accepted that he has earning a lot of money by selling forged lottery tickets. On the basis of self statement of the informant Kishanganj P.S. Case No. 59/2026 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. Allegation alleged in the FIR is totally false, fictitious concocted and far from truth. No case made out against the petitioner U/ 318(4), 338, 336(3) and rest sections are bailable in nature. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered from position or permission of the petitioner. On perusal of the seizure list police take signature on the plain paper by the inducement t of false promise with the purpose of prepared a fake seizure. The petitioner undertake that all the condition imposed by this Court. The petitioner is only earning member of the family. As para 03 of the bail petition, the petitioner has clean antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail and prayed to disposes the anticipatory bail petition.

5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation against they illegally sells lottery tickets which is prohibited in Bihar. Co-accused Md. Nasim who was arrested by the police has disclosed before the police that these petitioners are suppliers the lottery tickets to them. There is allegation against these petitioners he use to purchase lottery tickets from the co-accused persons and sells the same in the market.. From perusal of case diary it transpires that all the witnesses are police witnesses. There is no statement of any independent witness in the case diary. Allegation against the petitioners is serious in nature.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and nature of allegation, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and as such the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner Pappu is hereby **rejected**.
