1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Aghori @ Shyam Prasad Harijan who is in judicial custody since 21-02-2026 in connection with Kishanganj P. S. case No. 157 / 2026 registered u/s 115 (2), 109 (1), 126 (2), 191 (2), 191 (3), 303 (2), 324 (2), 351 (2), 352 of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the state.

2. Prosecution case in short is that on 20-02-2026 the petitioner and three co- accused persons assaulted the informant with hammer. The co- accused Bulbul assaulted him with hammer upon his head. All the accused persons assaulted him with fist and leg. The accused persons also took mobile phone and Rs. 5500/- from him.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Offence u/s 109 (1) of the BNS is not attracted against the petitioner. Both the parties have compromised the case and certified copy of the compromise petition has been brought on record. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

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5. Perused the record and case diary. As per allegation, the petitioner and co- accused persons assaulted the informant with hammer. The co- accused Bulbul assaulted him with hammer upon his head. From injury report of the informant it appears that he sustained only one injury i.e. laceration on frontal region of skull simple in nature. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 21-02-2026. From para 52 of the case diary it appears that the petitioner is also accused in one other case. However, affidavit has been filed by son of the petitioner stating that the petitioner was accused in two other cases but both have been disposed of in view of compromise.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and detention period of the the petitioner, the petitioner Aghori @ Shyam Prasad Harijan is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
