08-04-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Md. Sadique, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kurlikot P.S. case no.-12/2026, registered u/s 64(1), 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 3(5) of BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution story as per written report of victim is that prior to one and half year ago of the date of FIR she has gone to Thakurganj Bazar. In the mean time near Thakurganj Bus Stand a boy come near her and said that he is her relative and he disclose his name Md. Sadik. After sometime he brought some edible items and gave her for eating the same. After eating the said edible item she became unconscious. After sometime the petitioner took her in a toto at some unknown place and committed rape with her and took her indecent video. When she became conscious then the petitioner said that he will marry with her and also said that she should not be disclose the fact to anyone. After that she made physical relation with her on various occasions. On 15.02.2026 at about 06:00 PM the petitioner called her near the Thakurganj bus stand and said he will deleted all the photos from his mobile. When she reached their then the petitioner took her in a toto to his house where his family members assaulted her and handed over to the police and demanded Rs. 10,00,000/- as dowry for commencement of marry. On the basis of written report of the informant Kurlikot P.S. Case NO. 12/2026 was registered.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Entire allegation are alleged in FIR are totally false, fabricated and concocted. The allegation lable on FIR is

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unbelievable because the informant has file a petition before the O.C. Kurlikot on 16.02.2026 from the perusal of both the petition it will find the context is different which shown falsity of this case. Informant is not pleased with her marriage, so she forcibly entered the house of the petitioner to compel him to marriage with her. At the time of occurrence on dated 15.02.2026 petitioner was at Ahmadnagar Maharashtra which is clear from the CCTV footage. On the set date of occurrence the petitioner family member call the police and police has vacated the informant from the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail and prayed to disposes the anticipatory bail petition.

5. From perusal of record it transpires that there is allegation of rape against the petitioner. All the witnesses have supported to prosecution case in their statement before the police. During investigation stated of victim was recorded U/s 183 BNSS in which she has stated that the petitioner committed rape with her. Investigation in this case is still pending. Allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and nature of allegation, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and as such the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner Md. Sadique is hereby **rejected**.
