16-04-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Munjir Alam @ Munajir Alam who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kochadhaman P. S. Case No. 392/2025 registered u/s 317 (4), 317 (5) of the BNS. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case in short is that on 22-09-2025 the informant police officer saw a black colour motorcycle without number plate coming from the side of Chargariya. On being signaled to stop the rider started fleeing away who was apprehended. He disclosed his name and address as of the co- accused Naushad Alam. He did not produce any document with regard to the motorcycle. He disclosed that he purchased the motorcycle from the petitioner and he used to go with him for committing theft of vehicle. On verifying with e-chalan machine it was found that the said vehicle was stolen vehicle. The owner of the vehicle was contacted on phone. He disclosed that his motorcycle was stolen from Araria.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. There is no recovery from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner's name has come in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co- accused. The petitioner has clean antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Perused the record, case diary and connected session trial record. As per allegation, the co- accused Naushad Alam who was apprehended with a stolen motorcycle without number plate on the spot has stated name of the petitioner in the alleged occurrence. Witnesses in case diary have supported the prosecution version. From para 38 of the case diary, it appears that the owner of the vehicle disclosed that his motorcycle was stolen away on 19-05-2023 by some unknown. The petitioner is named accused of FIR. The co- accused Naushad Alam has confessed that the said stolen motorcycle has been purchased from this petitioner. The case is under investigation with regard to this petitioner. From para 8 of the supplementary case diary it appears that the petitioner is also accused in three other cases.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and involvement of the petitioner in the alleged occurrence, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and as such the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner Munjir Alam @ Munajir Alam is hereby **rejected**
