23-05-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners namely, 1. Masina 2. Hasiruddin @ Md. Asir, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. case no.-83/2025, u/s 64(1), 126(2), 76, 351(2), 351(3), 151(3), 352, 3(5) of BNS and 67(A) of IT Act. Also heard learned P. P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case in brief as per typed FIR is that on 18.09.2025 at about 11:00 AM, when the informant reached near Pothakhali Chowk, her brother-in-law forcibly made her drink a cold drink, after which she became unconscious. Then he took her to a room in hotel Royal Palace, Thakurganj, where he raped her and recorded a video, which was later made viral. When she informed her parents and they went to Mohsin's house where accused family members abused them and assaulted the informant and her parent, tore her clothes and threatened them and forcibly expelled them from the house.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence. Entire allegation alleged in the FIR are totally false, fabricated and concocted. co-accused has been granted bail namely Immamuddin through ABP No. 610/2025 on 06.01.2026 by the Ld. This Court. The allegation U/s 164(A), 164(2), 76 of BNS and 66A IT Act is not attracted against these petitioners. The petitioners are not main accused of this case. The allegation against the petitioner is bailable in nature. The petitioners are the ready to accept all condition which has been imposed by Ld. Court. Statement has been made in para 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has clean antecedent.

4. Learned P. P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

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5. From perusal of record it transpires that allegation against these petitioners is that when the informant went to the house of these petitioner regarding complaining the occurrence which co-accused Mohsin Reza committed with her then these petitioners assaulted and abused the informant and her family members and ousted her from their house. Allegation of rape is against co-accused Mohsin Reza. There is allegation against these petitioner is only to abuse and assault. Considering the facts stated above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioners namely, 1. Masina 2. Hasiruddin @ Md. Asir are hereby directed to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from of receipt of the copy of this order in learned Trial Court, on furnishing bail bond of the amount of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS.
